2022 Junior/Senior Virginia Trip Scholarship Requirements

In order for your trip to be completely paid for, you must meet all of the requirements below. Partial credit will be considered for most things. If you meet 100% of the requirements, we will cover 100% of trip costs minus personal expenses. 90% completion gets 90% of costs paid, 80% completion gets 80%, 70% completion gets 70%, and so on. The total trip cost is \$1,200. You can go on the trip even if you don't complete any of the scholarship requirements; however, you will not receive any Kingdom Builders scholarship funds.

The requirements for receiving the full amount of Kingdom Builders scholarship funds are broken down into four categories: Spiritual, Financial, Service, and Trip Preparation. These requirements must be met during the 4 months prior to the trip (April 2022–July 2022.)

Spiritual - *This category has four requirements and accounts for 30% of the scholarship available:*

1. Attend Wednesday evening student service at least two times per month.
2. Attend Sunday morning service at least two times per month.
3. Follow along and complete the team Bible Reading Plan.
4. Read the team book and discuss it at team meetings.

Financial - *This category has one requirement and accounts for 20% of the scholarship available:*

1. Make and keep a Speed The Light giving goal for the next 4 months.
 - a. Evangel teaches and encourages tithing on income (giving 10%) and giving above that amount to missions and outreach efforts. Give using a giving envelope marked with your name and "Speed The Light."

Service - *This category has three requirements and accounts for 25% of the scholarship available:*

1. Serve in a church department at least once a month.
2. Serve at two Evangel Archie service events.
 - a. All Church Work Day (April 9)
 - b. Cass County Rescue Mission (April 30)
 - c. Archie Fireworks (June 25)

Trip Preparation - *This category has two requirements and accounts for 25% of the scholarship available:*

1. Attend 5 Team Training Sessions
 - a. April 3

- b. May 1
 - c. June 5
 - d. July 10
 - e. July 24
2. Turn in all assigned paperwork on time (see info sheet.)
